Clues for Detective Clue Sheet

CLUE WEEK TWO:

CLUE: Across the world, children are caring for children because one or both parents have died of poverty, disease, war, famine and other causes. They face lives of loneliness, hardship and hunger. Many of them end up begging for food, living on the streets, or worse. Zoe Empowers partners with communities where orphaned and vulnerable children live. TOGETHER, they bring children into supportive groups and connect them to local resources, training and churches that empower them to break the cycle of poverty in just three years.

CLUE WEEK THREE:

Clue: Once children enter the Zoe Empowers program, they form working groups which are similar to our clubs at school...or our detective club! Each week the head of the household (usually the oldest sibling) will travel to meet together. The group elects leaders such as president, vice president, secretary and treasurer. The group supports each other as they work to learn new skills such as business and farming. The group also works on a large project together such as growing food that they can sell and bring more money into the group. When asked about the group experience most children say, "WE are a family."

CLUE WEEK FOUR:

CLUE: Partners ARE an important part of the Zoe Empowers model and can be churches, businesses, families or individuals. These partners raise money for Zoe Empowers which allows for trainings in health, hygiene, safety and child rights as well as the funds to start up their new businesses.

KEYWORD: ARE

CLUE WEEK FIVE:

CLUE: Through Zoe Empowers, children become empowered which means they are stronger, more confident, and in control of their lives. As older siblings make an income through running businesses and farming, children eat better and their siblings are able to return to school. Health and education are keys to moving them out of poverty. Once Zoe children complete the Zoe model they are empowered and never need charity again.
